Congratulations to Mrs. Glendale Boone as Madam Chair and Mr. Ray Felton as Vice Chair.

Dr. Williams turned the meeting over to Madam Chair Boone.

Ms. Deja Gainey, representing Mrs. Barbara Toti, signed up for public comments. She provided information about the 5th Annual Gates County Polar Plunge for Special Olympics, to be held on January 30, 2016. She invited everyone to attend, and said there is still a need for more food venders.

Mrs. Sallie Ryan also signed up for public comments and gave information about the Open Wide Outreach Ministry. This ministry, through St. Mary's Episcopal Church in Gatesville, and with the help of concerned citizens, is providing food bags for needy children to take home from school, for the week-end. The parents or guardians complete an application, and the information is kept confidential, known only by the principals and guidance counselors. Currently, the ministry is servicing 27 students. She had sample bags for the board members to see what is enclosed. Mrs. Ryan said there is a need for this ministry, and encouraged others to get involved.

Mrs. Gail Hawkins shared information about current events at Buckland Elementary during the Academic Report, and provided an entertaining video of the students.

Deja Gainey and Jay Brooks presented a powerpoint with Good News from the schools.

During the Superintendent's Report, Dr. Williams and board members recognized the Holiday Card Art Contest winners from each school and presented them with a certificate.
